Time: 5 minutes

<PRESENTAION>

Time: 15 minutes

Aids: flashcards, Blackboard

Use flashcards to induce new vocabulary and structures.

Lesson day is Tuesday. Then I place these three cards in order.

Last weekend > Yesterday > Today And explain students how time has

passed and when is the present and when is the past

Repeat the words one time

Use blackboard to present structures

I verb(pest tense)

I do	my homework
I did	my homework last weekend
I play	Video games
I played	Video games last weekend
I play	With my friends
I played	With my friends

Let students repeat for one time

<PRACTICE>

Single word prompts: play video games -> I played video games last weekend.

do homework -> I did my homework last weekend.

Pair work activity

Guessing game (Mime): Call one students to the front and do mime about what he/she did last weekend. Other students will guess what he or she did.

<READING>

Pre-reading activity Ask questions about the picture in the book.

- Q. What do you think is the main character doing?
- O. How does he look like?
- Q. Who is the main character with?
- Q. What do you think he did last weekend?

Give them Summary of the book with blanks

Reading material: 'Diary of a Wimpy Kid' written by Jeff Kinney

Fill in the blanks

<PRODUCTION>

Students write what they did last weekend as a diary form with at least 5 sentences.

Time limit: 7 minutes. Later make students present them in front of the students
