# IN-CLASS

## 1. Attendance Policy

**Students are required to have a minimum attendance rate of seventy percent (70%) in each course.**

- Students must provide medical documentation if they are absent due to illness for three(3) or more consecutive instructional days. Medical documentation may be faxed or emailed to Student Services .
- Students must notify in writing or email the relevant Faculty Member and/or Student Services prior to foreseen absences.
- Students are responsible for making arrangements to acquire lecture notes and assignment instructions for the missed classes. Based on the requirements in this policy, students who have missed thirty percent (30%) or more of their classes due to unauthorized absences will receive an incomplete mark for their course.

## 2. Late Policy

**Students who are 15 minutes or more late to class will not be allowed to enter the class.**

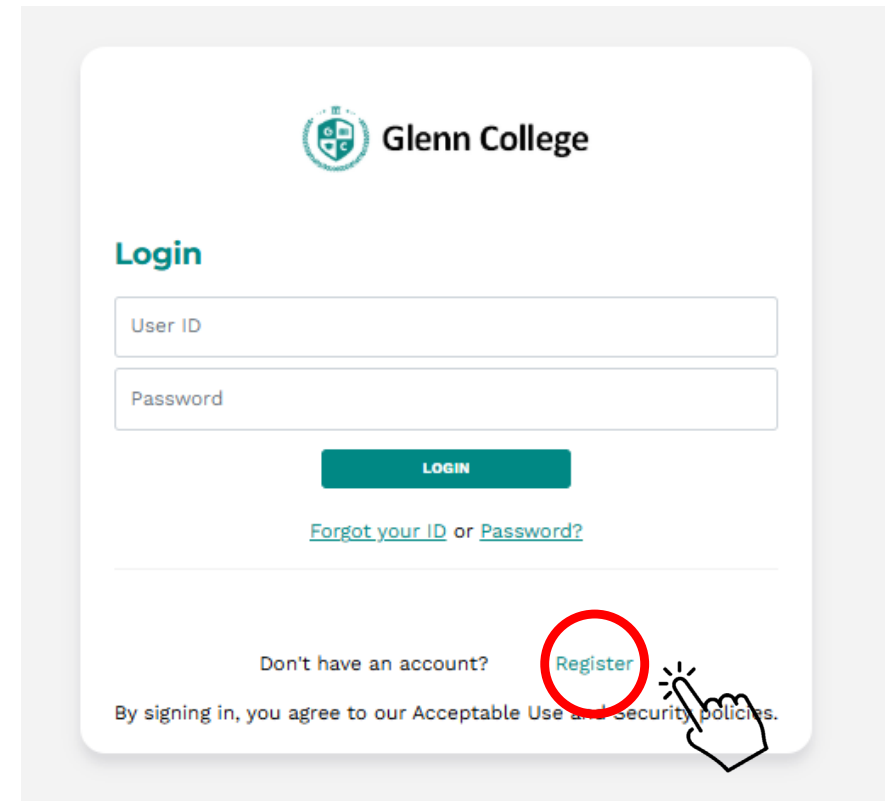

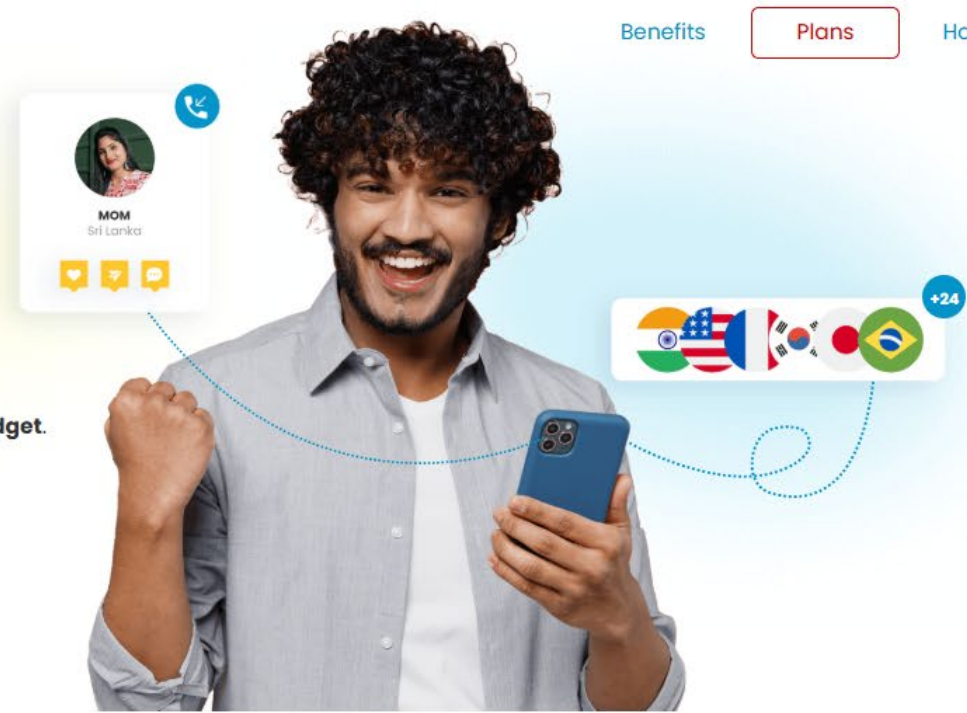

## Information on Tenancy Rights (British Columbia)

### Right for Tenants in BC

- Tenants have the right to safe, clean, and habitable accommodation.
- Landlords must provide a written tenancy agreement.
- Rent increases must follow BC government guidelines and notice periods.
- Landlords cannot enter the unit without proper notice.
- Damage deposits are regulated and cannot exceed half of one month's rent.
- Tenants cannot be evicted without lawful notice and valid legal grounds.
